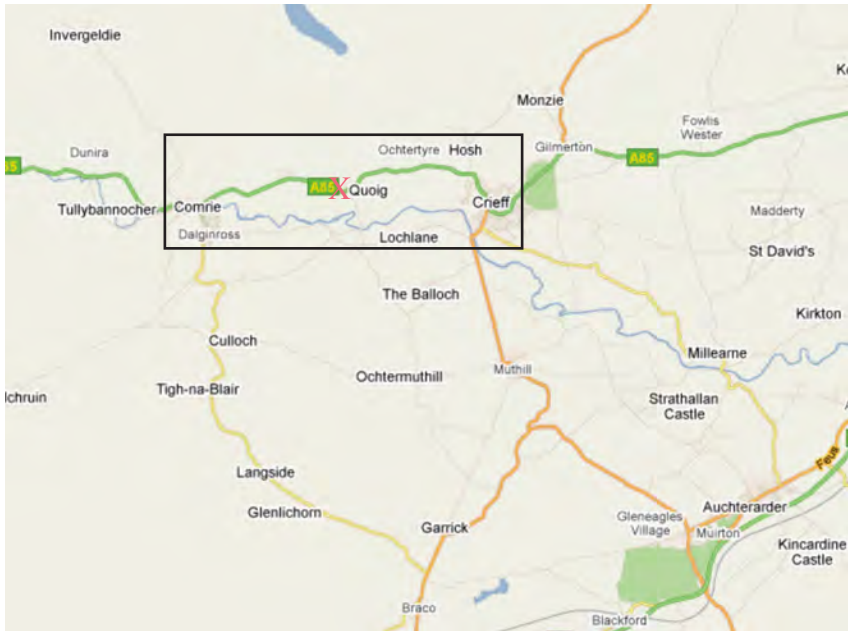


Ochertyre Song Weekend April 24, 2010

Some - key landmarks - keep on the Comrie road all the way

Coming from CRIEFF - before arriving- you will see **Monzievairst loch Chalets** (on your right 1.5 miles from hall); then **Locherlour Mill** (on your right, 0.7 miles from Hall); then **Quoig** (500 meters) then arrive to Green Building (Monzievairst Hall, to the right) drive into the Parking -see photos below -.

BUS: Stagecoach Perth BUS 15/15A from Perth bus station -close to train station (running from Perth to st Fillans) stops in front of the HALL (ASK driver)
